

Net Use Policy Exceptions

When creating an Internet usage policy for your library, you may put in place many restrictions, for legal, resource management, and ethical reasons. At times, however, certain patrons may have needs that are not met by such policies. Consider setting up some framework for evaluating legitimate exceptions to the policy. This may involve consultation between at least two staff members, or there may be set guidelines specifying that certain circumstances (such as an upcoming job application deadline, or a personal health concern) may permit a patron to use a computer in excess of posted time limits.
